I am sure all of you Baba's tapaswi children are enjoying the sweetness of introversion by sitting in the cottage of your forehead in the avyakt month of January. Truly, this month of Baba is a month of blessings, which enables you to experience an easy yogi life. Only the one Beloved Baba is residing in everyone's eyes and all are lost in that deep love for Baba. Only we children know the experience of this unique bliss and remain lost in that sweetness. Our sweetest Baba has given us many beautiful inspirations for the New Year. Baba says: Children, become easy and elevated effort-makers. Use all your treasures of thoughts, breath, time, virtues and powers in a worthwhile way and success is guaranteed. I am sure all of you are making such intense effort.

Now, in the month of February, we will be making preparations to create a lot of splendour for celebrating Shiv Baba's Jayanti. I am sure all of you must have planned many beautiful programmes for celebrating Shiv Ratri. (A bulletin to all centres in Bharat was sent for having 67 programmes for celebrating the 67th Shiv Jayanti.) You can also create that splendour for the celebration of Shiv Jayanti for celebrating one whole week of Shiv Jayanti. Sweetest avyakt BapDada has send a special message that according to the time, you children have been giving lectures, and held exhibitions and seminars, but now, together with serving through words, you also have to become equal to the Father and with love from your heart, enable Baba's message to reach the hearts of the people. Become master bestowers and give a drop of spiritual experience. On Shiv Jayanti, we all also make a promise. BapDada's has pure hopes for us children. Anger or bossiness becomes a great obstacle in our purity and creates upheaval in our own stage and also the stage of others. So, now, on this Shiv Ratri, let all children surrender this form of fire and become cool deities. Finish the seed of arrogance and offer determined thoughts of uck flowers, the bitter words, so that with the completion of the fire of anger, you will easily become a form of the fire of yoga and the form of revelation will come in front of you.

So, in order to fulfil this desire of BapDada, I had a few pure thoughts today, which I am writing here. As soon as all of you receive this letter, I am sure all of you will race in your efforts.

1. *Each one to check the self in a subtile way and keep a chart to see to what extent you have become free from anger and bossiness, that is, subtle arrogance. (A very simple form of this chart is also enclosed.)*
2. *Every morning, in the murli class, when traffic control song is played for 5 minutes, to have a little bit of extra meditation, according to discipline.*
3. *Shiv Baba is also called Rudra Baba. The rosary of Rudra or the rosary of victory is remembered of 108. The thought is that each Brahmin should make special time to have a minimum of 108 hours of yoga from now until Shiv Ratri so that the bitterness inside and the harsh sanskars easily finish. For this, each one should continue to fulfil their worldly responsibilities and maybe have 4 hours of meditation in the morning, then you will easily be able to complete the 108 hours. If it is possible, you can also have special yoga bhatthis.*
4. *Special invaluable teachings of BapDada is also being sent with this letter. Please study them daily and have the pure thought to imbibe these teachings in your practical life.*

With pure wishes for the Jayanti of our Bholanath Shiv Baba, and so the Jayanti of all of us children and also the Jayanti of the golden age.
